■ DESCRIPTION

The workshop has the purpose of bringing together Law PhD researchers from the EUI and SSSUP to present draft chapters of their work or other research papers and receive feedback from their peers and from faculty of both institutions. It also aims to enhance links and intellectual ties between both communities of researchers.

The joint workshop has become a regular event that helps to widen the horizon of our respective intellectual communities and to create conversations between them. It has served to trigger further connections and exchanges for the benefit of each PhD student.

Any PhD researcher from the EUI or the SSSUP can apply to present a draft paper at the workshop, on any topic related to their research project.

Given the number of the researchers, the submission of an abstract is required in order to start the selection process. The submission of the abstract in order to partake in the selection process is itself an opportunity for all PhD researchers to test the attractiveness and the innovative character of their writing projects.

■ IMPORTANT DATES

PhD researchers in law at each institution should submit an abstract of no more than 500 words of their proposed paper to alessandra.delogu@santannapisa.it by **28 June 2018**.

Those selected to present their work will be notified at the latest by **10 July 2018**.

Full draft papers must be submitted by **10 October 2018**.

Up to 12 papers will be selected for the workshop. Papers shall be discussed by doctoral researchers and faculty of the European University Institute and Scuola Sant'Anna.
